TRINITY GUILDHALL EXAMINATIONS

If your child has been entered for the May session please make sure that you have sent in the correct exam fee. It will soon be time for students to demonstrate their playing skills to an external examiner. In order to help with preparation:

Please keep to a regular practise routine – it is sometimes easier to practise in the mornings especially if there are lots of after school activities going on during the week.

Use a timer to ensure that practise sessions are not cut short

Make sure your child practises scales and exercises as well as pieces. They are all important components of the exam.

Stage a concert in your house – have the family sit down and watch your child perform their piece. This is a good exercise to get them used to playing in front of an audience.

Your child will soon be given a practise CD – make sure this is played and listened to regularly. It will help with timing of rhythms and will allow parents to hear what each piece should sound like.

Examinations will be held in May at Cayman Prep and High School (Smith Road).
